

NOTICE ON REVISED TOURIST PERMIT REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

This is to inform all tour guides that there will be changes to the tourist permit registration process. The revised procedures are as follows:

1. Advance Pre-Registration

The advance pre-registration requirement for tourist permits will be revised from 24 hours prior to the travel date to **48 hours** prior to the travel date. All tour guides are therefore requested to plan accordingly and ensure that tourist permit applications are submitted within the required 48-hour timeframe.

2. Walk-in Registration

The timing for walk-in registration will also be changed from **6:00 AM** to **6:00 PM**. Tour guides are requested to take note of the revised timing and make the necessary arrangements accordingly.

3. Registration Method

Registration under the revised process will be facilitated through either a QR code scan or a registration link. Detailed instructions, along with the official notification on the revised registration process will be announced.

4. Trial and Transition Period

These changes have been discussed and planned for rollout this month with the intention of providing tour guides with sufficient time to understand, prepare, and become familiar with the revised tourist permit registration process.

The current month will be treated as a trial and transition period. During this period, continuous reminders, guidance, and support will be provided to tour guides to help ensure a smooth transition and proper understanding of the new requirements.

All tour guides are encouraged to make full use of this transition period to familiarize themselves with the revised procedures.

5. Strict Implementation from October

Please be informed that from October onwards, the revised tourist permit registration requirements will be strictly implemented and followed without exception.

Tour guides are therefore requested to take note of the changes and make the necessary preparations during the trial period to avoid any inconvenience once the revised procedures come into full effect.
